

AAU-Sanctioned Youth Wrestling Tournament

Coach's information:

AAU Cards – coaches must have AAU cards PRINTED OUT and on a lanyard. This is a new AAU policy and we will be enforcing it. No cards on phones will be allowed.

AAU Age Divisions for 2025-26:

6U - Born 2019 and after **8U** - Born 2017 - 2018 **10U** - Born 2015 - 2016 **12U** - Born 2013 - 2014 **14U** - Born 2011 - 2012

Registration: On trackwrestling.com, event name is 2025 Spartan Kickoff Rescheduled. The deadline for enter wrestlers is 11:59 pm Thursday, December 25th. Weights submitted must be accurate and verified by club administrator prior to entering registrations. All participants must have a current AAU membership. AAU membership IS NOT included as part of the entry fee to the event. AAU membership must be obtained before the competition. Participants are encouraged to visit the AAU web site www.aausports.org to obtain their membership, or contact their club leader to get this information. This event is licensed by the Amateur Athletic Union of the U. S., Inc.

Cost: \$35 per wrestler. Individuals can register and pay on their own through TrackWrestling or through their club. Contact your club leader for information on how they want you to register. Payment is online and must be submitted at the time of registration.

We will open registration for girls-only divisions. As long as there are enough registrants, girls will be placed in all-girl brackets. If there are not enough participants, girls may be placed in brackets with boys to ensure they still have the opportunity to wrestle. If the wrestler or their parents/guardians do not want them to wrestle boys and they were placed in a mixed bracket, we can pull them from the tournament and issue a refund. Refunds will not include the processing fee charged by TrackWrestling and will be less than the full \$35 registration amount.

Format: Wrestlers in each division will be grouped by weight and experience rating. Please rate each of the wrestlers on your roster based on their experience/success level. Experience levels are the following:

- 4 = Beginner (<u>first year only</u>)
- 3 = At least one year experience / fair to average / has not placed at AAU state tournament
- $2 = \text{Good} / \text{has placed } 5^{\text{th}} 6^{\text{th}} \text{ at AAU state tournament or qualified for USA state tournament}$
- 1 = Excellent / placed top 4 in AAU state tournament (blue division) or placed top 6 at USA state tournament

We will do our best to group wrestlers by experience. Beginners are encouraged to compete and will be bracketed with other beginners. A beginner is defined as a first-year wrestler.

Brackets: Brackets will consist **mostly** of 4- or 5-man round-robins.

Awards: Medals to top three place winners in each bracket.

Admission is free and full concessions will be available all day.
